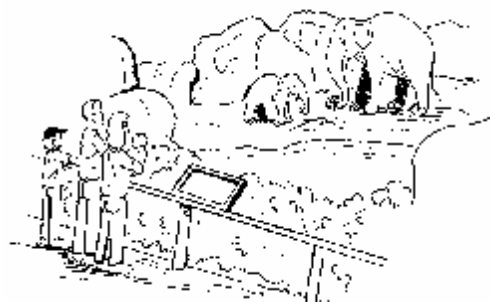




CINCINNATI ZOO & BOTANICAL GARDEN



The Kids' Favorites Self-Guided Tour



Keep your kids active and excited during your Zoo visit with this itinerary.

1) Children's Zoo

Begin your tour at the Children's Zoo, where your kids can climb on a rope spider web, feed a goat, and meet live animals during a Frisch's Discovery Program.



2) Train

Take a train ride for a closer look at the wolves, flamingos, and Swan Lake.

3) Lorikeet Landing

Cross the train tracks for a trip to Lorikeet Landing. One dollar buys you a cup of nectar and an experience of a lifetime as these colorful parrots land on your hand to lap up the sweet stuff.



4) Lords of the Arctic

Turn the corner and travel downhill to the polar bear underwater viewing window and watch the great white bear in action.

5) Manatee Springs

Follow the path to Manatee Springs and marvel at the antics of our two resident sea cows. Kids can climb into a special viewing "bubble".



6) 4-D Special FX Theater

More than just a family-friendly movie, the 4-D Special FX Theater will excite all your senses.

7) Carousel

Head towards Safari Camp to board the carousel. Kids can merrily go round while riding on their favorite Zoo animals.

8) Wings of Wonder Theater

Walk up the hill to the Wings of Wonder Theater. If it's show season, enjoy comedic stylings of our bird trainers and their wonderful winged friends.



9) World of the Insect

Farther up on the right, enter the World of the Insect and investigate the amazing world of ants. A Wild Research station encourages kids to participate in real science as they count ants and calculate their speed.



10) Gorilla World

Follow the trail to Gorilla World. Kids can hoot like a gorilla, learn which gorilla they are most like, and find out if gorillas have friends at another Wild Research station.

11) Elephant Reserve

Keep to the right to reach the Elephant Reserve, where you can meet our Asian elephant family. If you're lucky, you just might catch them taking a bath!



12) Discovery Forest & Education Center

Walk around the bend and immerse yourself in a world of green in the Discovery Forest. Be sure to stop in the Education Center lobby and register for a Zoo class.

13) Giraffe Ridge

Stroll down the boardwalk to Giraffe Ridge, where the giraffes will be eating out of the palm of your hand as you feed them crackers.



14) Zoo Shop

No Zoo visit can be complete without a souvenir to remind your kids of their fun-filled day. On your way back through the main entrance, pick up a memento at the Zoo Shop.
